SPRING NOVICE SHOWING SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

YOUR SIGNATURE ON THE ENTRY FORM SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **ALL** classes will be run under the Rules of the relevant Societies/Championship Organisers.
2. **TELEPHONE and EMAIL ENTRIES** will be accepted. Telephone or email entries cannot be guaranteed until the fee is received. Entries will not be refunded except under the rules referred to in Clause 1 or on production of a vet's certificate with a £2 deduction to cover administration costs.
3. **THE** Show reserves the right to cancel add to or amend any of the classes as it thinks fit; alter advertised times; refuse entry without stating the reason. PLEASE REGULARLY CHECK OUR FACEBOOK PAGE.
4. **THE** decision of the Organiser and/or the judges is final.
5. **HEALTH & SAFETY:**
 - (a) All events are organised in accordance with H & S legislation. The organisers will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of those attending the show. For these measures to be effective everyone attending must take similar precautions to prevent and avoid accidents and obey the instructions of the organisers, stewards, judges and other officials.
 - (b) Dogs are not permitted in the competition or car parking areas. They must be kept on a lead in the lorry parking area.
 - (c) Bicycles, roller blades, scooters, etc. are not permitted on the showground
 - (d) Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside boxes/trailers and left unattended or tied to any gates or fences.
 - (e) If any horse/pony has been in contact with any infectious disease it should not attend the show.
 - (f) No lunging is allowed in the parking or warm-up areas.
 - (g) All vehicles should enter and leave the parking area with due consideration for others and vehicles should be parked in a sensible manner.
 - (h) Hay and other rubbish must not be left on the showground and droppings should be removed. Droppings can be placed tidily on the muck heap at the showground.
6. **STALLIONS:** The following rule applies to members and non-members of all organisations competing or preparing to compete at the show.

*No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in the show without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury. **STALLION DISCS MUST BE WORN. No rider/handler under 15yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class.***
7. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the show, its officers, servants or agents, the show shall be under NO liability for injury, loss or damage, however occasioned, suffered by competitors, spectators, their property servants or horses in connection with or arising out of the show.
8. **Competitors/owners** must have their own insurance which includes suitable public liability cover.
9. **OBJECTIONS** accompanied by a deposit of £50 must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, such deposit to be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

Qualifiers (Q) for the Sunshine Tour. (Obtain your card direct from the Qualifying Society)

All classes except Class 13 are qualifiers for The Showing Register (TSR) South Finals 2018 to be held at the Denmead Autumn Show on 9 Sep 2018. (1st & 2nd riders qualify, cards will be handed out in the ring)

Entries will not be ridden by the judge and will not be stripped (except Open Show class 14) but you will be asked to do an individual show.

Start 9.00 am

- Class 1 Novice Pony up to 14.2 any type including First Ridden Q
- Class 2 Novice Riding Pony any type Q
- Class 3 Novice M&M registered and unregistered (excluding welsh ponies) any height Q
- Class 4 Novice Welsh Ponies large and small breeds Q
- Class 5 Novice Coloured Pony to include Palomino and any other odd coloured Q
- Class 6 Novice Lead Rein Q

NETTEX & LRG PONY CHAMPIONSHIP (OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS FROM CLASSES 1 TO 6)

Not before 12.30 pm

- Class 7 Novice Hunter exceeding 15hh Q
- Class 8 Novice Riding Horse exceeding 15hh to include part bred (PBA) and Arabs Q
Special rosette to the highest placed PBA or Arab
- Class 9 Novice Cob exceeding 14.2hh including Maxi Cobs Q
- Class 10 Novice ROR for horses that have been in training raced or un-raced
- Class 11 Novice Hack exceeding 15hh Q
- Class 12 Novice Riding Club Horse to include part bred (PBA) and Arabs exceeding 14.2hh

NETTEX & LRG HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP (OPEN TO 1ST AND 2ND PRIZE WINNERS FROM CLASSES 7 TO 12)

- Class 13 Training Class open to all who want to get the judge opinion and recommendation for future class selection exceeding 14.2hh
- Class 14 Open Show Class open to hacks, cobs, riding horses and hunters exceeding 15hh to be ridden by a judge and stripped
