SHOWTIME NOVICE SHOWING SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS (Revised Aug 2019)

YOUR SIGNATURE ON THE ENTRY FORM SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **PRE-ENTRIES** will be accepted until **three days** before the date of the show.

(a) **POSTAL and EMAIL ENTRIES** will be accepted. Email entries cannot be guaranteed until the fee is received. Entries will not be refunded except on production of a vet's certificate with a £2 deduction to cover administration costs.

2. **ENTRIES ON THE DAY** - Cash only

3. **THE** Show reserves the right to cancel add to or amend any of the classes as it thinks fit; alter advertised times; refuse entry without stating the reason. PLEASE REGULARLY CHECK OUR FACEBOOK PAGE.

4. **THE** decision of the Organiser and/or the judges is final.

5. **HEALTH & SAFETY:**

(a) All events are organised in accordance with H & S legislation. The organisers will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of those attending the show. For these measures to be effective everyone attending must take similar precautions to prevent and avoid accidents and obey the instructions of the organisers, stewards, judges and other officials.

(b) Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside boxes/trailers and left unattended or tied to any gates or fences.

(c) Drones, bicycles, roller blades, scooters or similar are not permitted on the showground or car parking areas.

(d) Dogs are not permitted on the showground or car parking areas. Dogs must be confined to the owner's vehicle and must be kept on a lead in the lorry parking area. Dog mess is to be cleared up and poo bags taken home. **POO BAGS ARE NOT TO BE LEFT AROUND OR HUNG ON TREES OR FENCES.**

(e) No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in the show without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury. STALLION DISCS MUST BE WORN. No rider/handler under 15yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class.

(f) If any horse/pony has been in contact with any infectious disease it must not attend the show.

(g) No lunging is allowed in the parking or warm-up areas.

(h) All vehicles should enter and leave the parking area with due consideration for others and vehicles should be parked in a sensible manner.

(i) Hay and other rubbish must not be left on the showground and droppings should be removed. Droppings can be placed tidily on the muck heap at the showground.

6. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the show, its officers, servants or agents, the show shall be under NO liability for injury, loss or damage, however occasioned, suffered by competitors, spectators, their property servants or horses in connection with or arising out of the show.

7. **Competitors/owners** must have their own insurance which includes suitable public liability cover.

8. **OBJECTIONS** accompanied by a deposit of £50 must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, such deposit to be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

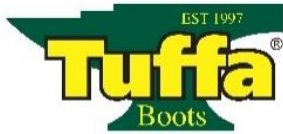
SHOWTIME UNAFFILIATED NOVICE SHOWING SHOW 20TH OCTOBER 2019

Open to horses and ponies not having won a cash prize of £20.00 or more in the current calendar year in any showing class. Any ridden class may be ridden astride or side saddle. **No class will be ridden by a judge with the exception of Classes 14 & 15 where horses exc. 15hh will be ridden by the judge.** There will be a short break between each class to enable competitors to practice ride in the arena.
