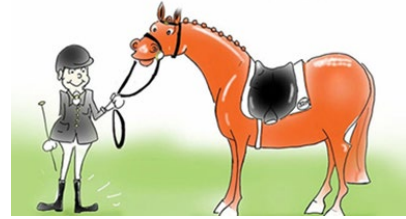

SHOWING WITH A DIFFERENCE RULES AND REGULATIONS

YOUR SIGNATURE ON THE ENTRY FORM SHALL BE CONSTRUED AS ACCEPTANCE OF THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **ENTRIES** pre-entry only. No late entries
2. **POSTAL and EMAIL ENTRIES** will be accepted. Email entries cannot be guaranteed until the fee is received. Entries will not be refunded except on production of a vet's certificate with a £2 deduction to cover administration costs.
3. **THE** Show reserves the right to cancel add to or amend any of the classes as it thinks fit; alter advertised times; refuse entry without stating the reason. PLEASE REGULARLY CHECK OUR FACEBOOK PAGE.
4. **THE** decision of the Organiser and/or the judges is final.
5. **HEALTH & SAFETY:**
 - (a) All events are organised in **accordance with H & S legislation and the COVID-19 guidelines in place at the time of the show**. The organisers will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the safety of those attending the show. For these measures to be effective everyone attending must take similar **precautions to abide by COVID-19 guidelines, including Track & Trace**, prevent and avoid accidents and obey the instructions of the organisers, stewards, judges, and other officials.
 - (b) Horses/ponies must not be tied up outside boxes/trailers and left unattended or tied to any gates or fences.
 - (c) Drones, bicycles, roller blades, scooters or similar are not permitted on the showground or car parking areas.
 - (d) Dogs are not permitted on the showground or car parking areas. Dogs must be confined to the owner's vehicle and must be kept on a lead in the lorry parking area. Dog mess is to be cleared up and poo bags taken home. **POO BAGS ARE NOT TO BE LEFT AROUND OR HUNG ON TREES OR FENCES.**
 - (e) **No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in the show without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury. STALLION DISCS MUST BE WORN. No rider/handler under 15yrs may exhibit a stallion in any class.**
 - (f) If any horse/pony has been in contact with any infectious disease it must not attend the show.
 - (g) No lunging is allowed in the parking or warm-up areas.
 - (h) All vehicles should enter and leave the parking area with due consideration for others and vehicles should be parked in a sensible manner.
 - (i) Hay and other rubbish must not be left on the showground and droppings should be removed. Droppings can be placed tidily on the muck heap at the showground.
6. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the show, its officers, servants or agents, the show shall be under NO liability for injury, loss or damage, however occasioned, suffered by competitors, spectators, their property servants or horses in connection with or arising out of the show.
7. **COMPETITORS/OWNERS** must have their own insurance which includes suitable public liability cover.
8. **PASSPORTS** must accompany all horses and ponies and may be requested for inspection.
9. **OBJECTIONS** accompanied by a deposit of £50 must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, such deposit to be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

DATA PROTECTION

Due to new data protection laws which came into force in 2018 we need to inform you that a photographer will be on site on the day of the show. If you do not wish to have your photos taken please inform the Show Secretary on the day.

COVID-19

Ensure you are familiar with the guidelines in place at the time of the show. Please note particularly:

You will need to bring a completed Track and Trace Form which can be downloaded from my website.

No general spectators are permitted.

Only bring horses and ponies that you have entered.

A one-way system to maintain distancing will be in place, please follow the signs.

We may amend the rules to comply with any changes in government policy.

- Judges will NOT ride you will need to do an individual show.
- Classes 1,2 and 3 open to Lead Rein.
- Your ridden show should show walk away from the judge trot, change of diagonal, and canter with a change of rein. NO galloping (except in a Championship).
- Exhibits will be stripped for conformation.
